

John 4:43–54 The Royal Official's Journey of Trust

43. After the two days he departed for Galilee.
44. (For Jesus himself had testified that **a prophet has no honor** in his own hometown.)
45. So when he came to Galilee, **the Galileans welcomed him**,
having seen all the that he had done in Jerusalem at the feast.
For they too had gone to the feast.

46. So **he came again** to Cana in **Galilee**, where he had **made the water wine**.
and there was a royal official whose son was sick in Capernaum.
47. This man, hearing that Jesus had come from Judea to Galilee, went to him and asked him to come down and heal his son, for he was **at the point of death**.
48. So Jesus said to him, **"Unless you people see signs and wonders you will never believe."**
49. The official said to him, "Sir, **come down** before **my child dies**."
50. Jesus said to him, "Go your way your son lives!"
So **the man** **believed** **the word** **that Jesus spoke to him**
and **he went on his way**.
51. As he was **going down**, his servants met him and told him, **"your son lives!"**.
52. So he asked them the hour when he began to get better, and they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour **the fever left him**."
53. So the father knew that was the hour when Jesus said to him, "Your son will live." **And he himself believed, and all his household**.
54. So **again** this **second sign** Jesus did when **he came** from Judea to **Galilee**.
