

Romans 8:31–39 — God’s Free Gift of Love in Jesus

31. What then shall we say in view of these things?

Since God is for us, who can be against us?

32. For since he did not spare his own Son,
but **gave him** over **for us all**

—how will he not also, along with him, freely give us all things?

33. Who shall bring any accusing charge against God’s elect?

It is God who justifies.

34. Who is the one who will condemn?

Christ is the one who died, and more, was raised
who also is at the right hand of God,
who also is interceding for us.

35. Who will separate us from the love of Christ?

Will trouble, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?

36. **Just as it is written, “For your sake we encounter death all day long;
We’ve been considered sheep to be slaughtered.” (Psalm 44)**

37. **No, in all these things we are more than conquerors
through him who loved us! (Psalm 45 answers Psalm 44)**

38. **For I am convinced that**

not **death**,
nor **life**,
nor **angels**,
nor *[spirit]* **rulers**,
nor things **present**,
nor things **to come**,

39. nor **powers**,
nor **height**,
nor **depth**,
nor **anything else in creation**

**shall be able to separate us from the love of God
that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.**
